

Google Meet – Download Instructions and Requirements

Supported Operating Systems:

Google Meet supports the current version and the 2 previous major releases of these operating systems:

- Apple® macOS®
- Microsoft® Windows®
- Chrome OS
- Ubuntu® and other Debian-based Linux® distributions

Supported Web Browser:

Google Meet works with the current version of the browsers listed below:

Additional Hardware and Network Requirements:

For Google Meet video meetings, you need:

- A broadband connection to the internet.
- A built-in web camera (with built-in mic) or external USB camera and external PC mic.
Note: Other devices, such as virtual cameras, might not work with Google Meet.
- 2.2 GHz Intel 2nd-generation i3/i5/i7, AMD equivalent or better, processor to support HD video.

- DESKTOP PC USERS
